- Official high school transcript or GED *ONLY IF* student is planning on utilizing financial aid or program eligibility
- Official transcripts from colleges in which you are intending to use previously completed credit for eligibility/degree requirements. Failure to submit and have transcripts evaluated could disqualify you from consideration.
- Transcript evaluation request on file in Admissions and Registration

Academic eligibility requirements:
Requirements must be completed before an applicant is allowed to take the HESI A2.
Coursework final grade must be a "C" or higher.

- ACT Math ≥ 22 or SAT ≥ 530 **

READING - *Prepared at the ENGL 1613 level by meeting one of these:*

- Completed ENGL 1613
- ACT English or Reading ≥ 19 **
- SAT Verbal/Reading ≥ 480 **
- ACCUPLACER Reading ≥ 80 or NextGen ≥ 256 **
- High school GPA of 2.7 **
